

# Terms & Conditions: Farm Camp Located at Ivy Bell Farm

## Introduction

These terms and conditions apply to programs organized by Ivy Bell Farm located at 122 Faucette Mill Rd, Hillsborough, North Carolina. The contract for the supply of any place on a particular camp is between Ivy Bell Farm and you. Your contract incorporates these terms and conditions and by making a booking with us you confirm your acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.

In these terms and conditions: “we” or “us” or “our” means Ivy Bell Farm (Farm Camps/Alexandra Albertson) at 122 Faucette Mill Rd, Hillsborough, North Carolina “you” or “your” means the relevant Participant(s) named on the registration form or where any Participant is under the age of 18, then that Participant’s parent or guardian who submits our registration form “Participant” means the person(s) named on the relevant registration form taking part in the relevant camp and where that person is under 18 includes where applicable his or her parents or guardians.

## GENERAL COMMITMENTS

1. By registering for Farm Camp on Ivy Bell Farm, you agree to these policies.
2. Children ages 4-13 can participate in Farm Camp located at Ivy Bell Farm.
3. Daily drop-off / check-in of Camper during the Camp Session will begin at 8:30 a.m. until 9:30 a.m (or at a time as otherwise directed by Ivy Bell Farm) outside on the side deck of the Ivy Bell Farm House. The drop-off / check-in of Camper may not occur without the presence of a Caregiver or the Authorized Adult. Parking is available on the front lawn, driveway, and street. Daily pick-up of Camper during the Camp Session will begin at 2:30 p.m and go to 3:00 pm. (or at a time as otherwise directed by Ivy Bell Farm). The pick-up of a Camper may not occur without the presence of a Caregiver or the Authorized Adult who must show a government issued photo ID. If Camper is not picked up within 10 minutes after the designated pick up time, Ivy Bell Farm will attempt to contact Caregiver, followed by the Authorized Adult. If the authorized pick up person is running late, the person must contact Ivy Bell Farm at (919) 923-0112.
4. **Signing in and out required:** We require that parents/guardians sign their children into and out of camp daily with signatures and time. These records are used to monitor attendance and calculate any fees for late pick-up, so please make sure to enter information correctly

and clearly. At pick-up time, staff will release campers only to someone listed on your authorized pick-up list.

5. **Fees for late pick-ups:** Please arrive on time to pick up your child each day. Pick-Ups start at 2:30 and go to 3:00pm. If Pick-Ups more than fifteen (15) minutes after the scheduled end time for a particular session are considered LATE PICK-UPS. All late pick-ups will be charged a \$25 fee. An additional \$10 fee will be charged for each 15-minute block of time thereafter until your child has been picked up from the farm. On-site staff does not have the authority to waive any fees.
6. The language spoken at camp is English, so a basic knowledge is a pre-requisite. By accepting this Terms and Conditions you confirm the ability of your child to have sufficient language skills for participation in the Farm Camp Program.
7. The directors reserve the right, at their discretion, to withdraw any camper whose influence or actions are deemed unsatisfactory, dangerous or incompatible to the Camp community or who will not live within the rules and policies of the Camp. If this occurs, no reduction or return of fee, or any part thereof will be made.
8. Children maintaining the highest standard of conduct is required at all times. Using profanity, disparaging dialogues, physical violence or threats during participation in Little Farms Mini camp is strictly prohibited. If a camper is dismissed for behavioral reasons, no refund will be issued. Camp rules and instructions of Little Farmers Mini-Camp counselors and staff must be followed at all times.
9. By accepting these Terms and Conditions, the parent confirms that his/her child has permission to participate in all camp activities.
10. By accepting these Terms and Conditions, parent confirms his/her acceptance that his/her child may be pictured/photographed and that such material can be used by Ivy Bell Farm and/or Ivy Bell Farm's business partners for promotion or marketing of Ivy Bell Farm.
11. The copyright of all photography appearing on our fliers or websites belongs to Ivy Bell Farm. No reproduction may be made without prior permission from the Ivy Bell Farm management.
12. In the event that a parent cannot be reached in an emergency when the child is under Ivy Bell Farms/Alexandra Albertson/employees of Ivy Bell Farm supervision, by accepting these Terms and Conditions, the parent gives permission to secure proper treatment for the child as needed.

13. By Accepting these Terms and Conditions the parent agrees to provide any medical or dietary needs prior to child's arrival.
14. Ivy Bell Farm does not provide meals or snacks for Camper and does not offer the ability to refrigerate any food or beverage. Camper should bring Camper's own lunch and a snack to eat or drink each day. Since Ivy Bell Farm does not have a refrigerator available for Camp attendees, the items should not require refrigeration.
15. All prescription medicine provided by a licensed Doctor must be turned into the camp staff upon arrival with instructions in English. This will be dispensed by camp staff only.
16. All your child's personal belongings are their own responsibility.. Expensive and treasured items such as jewelry, designer clothes or shoes, trainers, etc., should not be brought to the camp.
17. We are not responsible for loss, theft or damage to your property.
18. Parents agree to support Ivy Bell Farm Camp by encouraging children to abide by the highest standards of positive conduct. They will discuss constructive concerns, if any, regarding Little Farmers Mini Camp, counselor or staff behavior or company policies with Ivy Bell Farm management.
19. Parents agree to pay for property/personal injury damage caused directly, or indirectly, as a result of negligent action of their child.
20. We understand that due to the nature of camp activities, there remain risks that can result in loss or damage to property and/or loss or damage to the Participant, including accidental injury, illness, permanent trauma, disability or death.
21. Little Farmers Mini-camp participants are subject to numerous risks, including, but not limited to, environmental hazards such as weather conditions, water conditions, insects, animals, and natural conditions,
22. Release of all claims and covenant not to sue: as lawful consideration for being permitted by Ivy Bell Farm to participate in the program, parent and participant, on behalf of themselves, their heirs and/or successors, do hereby release, discharge, waive, and promise not to sue Ivy Bell Farm , and/or its respective owners, shareholders, directors, members, managers, administrators, employees, volunteers, other participants, sponsors, and/or all other persons or entities associated with Ivy Bell Farm and its programs for and from any and all liability, claims, demands, losses, damages for property damage, money damages, personal injury,

illness, and/or death arising from and/or related to the participant's participation in and/or involvement with Ivy Bell Farm and/or related to or arising out of this agreement

23. I understand that Under North Carolina law, there is no liability for an injury to or death of a participant in an agritourism activity conducted at this agritourism location if such injury or death results from the inherent risks of the agritourism activity. NC G.S. 99E-30-31

## **CONFIRMATION PROCESS:**

You will receive an automatic confirmation email upon completion of your registration. If you do not receive a confirmation email soon after registration, it likely means that there was a transaction error, and you are not registered. ## **CANCELLATION POLICY**

1. If a camper cancels less than 24 hours before due to medical reasons that can be fully documented with a physician's written explanation, a full refund will be sent to the participants.
2. If a camper cancels for any other reason before 72 hours, a full refund will be sent to the participant.

By payment of any sum to Ivy Bell Farm, you are acknowledging your agreement to the terms and Conditions of Ivy Bell Farm as described herein.

## **PRIVACY NOTICE**

Participation in Ivy Bell Farm Programs requires you to share both yours and your child's personal information with Ivy Bell Farm, including names, pictures, addresses, emails, medical data, and payment. Below is a brief description of how Ivy Bell Farm will use your information:

- Ivy Bell Farm will keep your information on file.

- Ivy Bell Farm will use personal information collected for the purpose of proactive communication and conducting of Farm Camp your child applied for.
- Ivy Bell Farm will share your information to respond to information requests of governmental authorities or where required by law.
